


DISCOVER OUR VARIETY OF LOCAL BEACHES, EACH WITH ITS UNIQUE FLAIR.

1. South Pointe Park Pier and South Point Beach (*15 minutes walk/0.7 mile)

Part of a 17-acre park with picnic areas, a playground, fishing pier, and great spots for cruise ship-watching.

2. Lummus Park Beach (*5 minutes walk/0.3 mile)

Runs from 5^{TH} to 15^{TH} St. with a winding pedestrian promenade, urban park, playground, volleyball courts, work out facilities and powdery white sand.

3. Miami Beach Central 21ST-46TH St. (*30 minutes walk/1.5 miles)

A popular area for strolling, jogging and skating thanks to the elevated boardwalk which runs from 21^{ST} to 46^{TH} St.

4. Miami Beach North 46TH-78TH St. (*16 minutes drive/4.2 miles)

Enjoyable and family-friendly with a play area at 46TH St. and often crowd-free.

5. Surfside (*26 minutes drive/8.6 miles)

A residential enclave with a coastal beach town vibe.

6. Haulover Beach Park (*31 minutes drive/10.9 miles)

Miles of white sand, ocean surf, landscaped dunes and shaded picnic areas, and designated clothing-optional beach.

7. Sunny Isles Beach (*39 minutes drive/13.2 miles)

Miles of public beaches, shops and oceanfront hotels.

8. Crandon Park, Key Biscayne (*20 minutes drive/11.9 miles)

Palm tree-lined park features shallow waters, barbecues and picnic tables, making it a favorite for families.

9. Bill Baggs Cape Florida State Park, Key Biscayne (*36 minutes drive/15.8 miles)

Located on the Southern tip of Key Biscayne, a great place to soak up the sun, bike, and tour the Cape Florida Lighthouse, South Florida's oldest building, circa 1825.
